

# Calvary Baptist Academy

## *Admissions Policy*

**Before a student can be admitted to Calvary Baptist Academy, parents must meet the following criteria:**

1. Members of a Bible believing church
2. Actively involved in a ministry of your church. Please list areas of active involvement:  

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3. Faithful to the regular services of your church. Attendance must be in-person. Regularly viewing services online is not sufficient to meet this requirement.
4. In full agreement with the philosophy of the school and willing to sign a Statement of Cooperation
5. In full agreement with the doctrinal statement of Calvary Baptist Church & Academy.
6. Recognize and respect the position that CBC/CBA ascribes to a traditional view of separation from the world including: rejecting worldly styles of music such and Rock and Roll, R&B, Modern Country, and Pop; rejecting the immorality of "Hollywood" found in the vast majority of movies and T.V. shows; and total abstinence from alcohol, mind altering drugs, and tobacco (Romans 12:1, 2; 2 Corinthians 5:17; Proverbs 20:1; I Corinthians 6:19,20)
7. Willing to be interviewed by the Administrator of the school
8. Submit a letter of recommendation from your pastor, confirming church membership, attendance, and involvement.
9. Recognize that Calvary Baptist Church and Academy reserves the right to not accept any student application based solely on the discretion of the administration and/or school board.

**Before being admitted to Calvary Baptist Academy, the student must meet the following criteria:**

1. 7<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> grade students must have a clear testimony of salvation.
2. Faithful to all of the regular services of their church. Attendance must be in-person. Regularly viewing services online is not sufficient to meet this requirement.
3. Shown to exhibit acceptable behavior
4. Interviewed by the Administrator of the school
5. Shown to exhibit a cooperative attitude toward the school as well as the authority of the teachers
6. Of reasonably good health and does not require special education accommodations that our school is not staffed nor equipped to provide.
7. Free from all communicable diseases
8. Be four years old by September 1<sup>st</sup> to enter K4, five years old by September 1<sup>st</sup> to enter K5, and six years old by September 1<sup>st</sup> to enter first grade
